#### Play at Good Pace and Keep Up —

- You should play at a good pace. Our time par is 4 hours and 15 minutes.
- It is your responsibility to keep up with the group in front of you.
- If you lose a clear hole and are delaying the group behind, after 2 warnings from our ranger, you will be asked to follow our ranger to a forward position on the course.

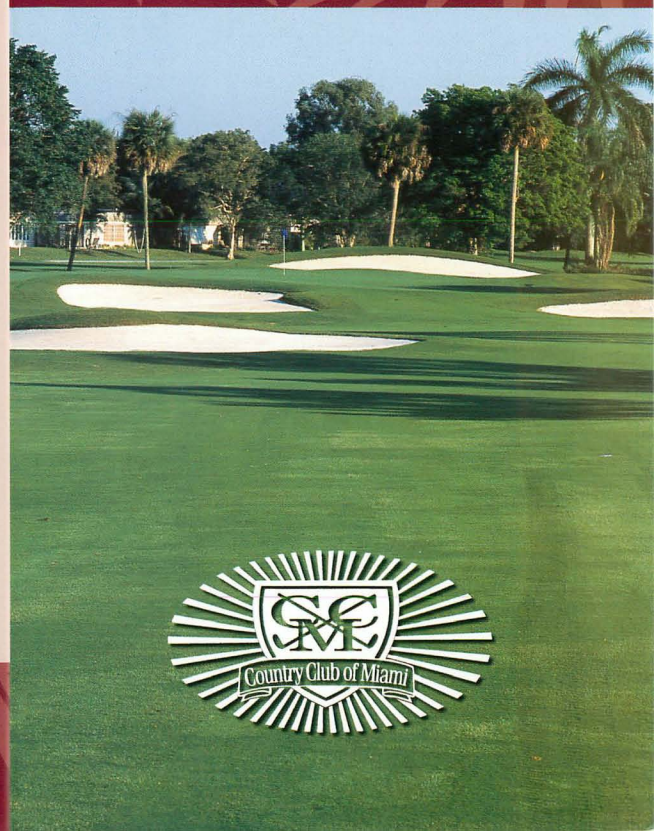
### GOLF CAR ETIQUETTE

- Golf carts must be driven on paths near teeing complexes.
- Between tee complexes and green complexes golf carts should remain on cart paths whenever possible.
- Please avoid driving in wet areas.
- To protect green complexes, once inside yellow ropes, golf carts must stay on cart paths or in the rough 30 feet from green.
- Please avoid driving on slopes around green complexes.

## USGA GOLF COURSE ETIQUETTE

- **Bunkers**— Before leaving a bunker, players should carefully fill up and smooth over all holes and footprints made by them and any nearby made by others.
- **Repair of Divots, Ball-Marks and Damage by Shoes**— Players should carefully repair any divot holes made by them and any damage to the putting green made by the impact of a ball (whether or not made by the player). On completion of the hole by all players in the group, damage to the putting green caused by golf shoes should be repaired.

- **Water Hazards**— All water hazards on the courses are lateral hazards and are indicated by the red stakes and/or red lines.
- **Out-of-Bounds** is defined by white stakes and private property fences bordering golf course.
- Play should be completed in 4 hours 15 minutes; keep pace with group ahead; allow faster players through.
- **Proper attire required at all times.**
- **Rangers are provided for the benefit of all golfers. All golfers must follow instructions.**
